Cause of Our Joy Goldendoodles Health Guarantee

All of our puppies are guaranteed to be healthy and free from visible signs of infection or contagious diseases at the time of purchase.

7-Day Return Policy

If you return your puppy for any reason, other than an accident, within 7 days of purchase, we will gladly accept the puppy back and refund 100% of the purchase price.

Two-Year Genetic Health Guarantee

If your puppy is diagnosed by a qualified veterinarian with a life-threatening or seriously disabling certain congenital or genetic defect within the first two years, we will refund 100% of the purchase price or cover treatment costs, up to the purchase price, at a veterinary clinic that we approve. We may require a second opinion from a veterinarian of our choice at our expense. If the puppy is euthanized or otherwise disposed of without this second opinion, the buyer forfeits all rights to a refund.

This guarantee covers both common and uncommon diseases of definite genetic or congenital origin that significantly affect your dog's quality of life. Examples include severe hip dysplasia, Grade 4 patella luxation, and Grade 3 elbow dysplasia, provided the dog is not sterilized before 12 months of age and is maintained at a healthy weight. It also includes Grade IV or V heart murmurs present in the puppy stage that persist after 20 weeks of age.

Additionally, all genetic diseases in Goldendoodles or Bernedoodles (depending on your puppy's breed) that we can screen for in our parent dogs are covered by this quarantee, including:

For Goldendoodles and Bernedoodles both:

- Degenerative Myelopathy (DM)
- Neonatal Encephalopathy with Seizures (NEWS)
- Progressive Rod-Cone Degeneration (PRA-prcd)
- Von Willebrand's Disease type 1 (vWD1)

In addition, for Goldendoodles:

- Muscular Dystrophy Golden Retriever Type (GRMD)
- Ichthyosis Golden Retriever Type (ICH1/GR)
- Golden Retriever Progressive Retinal Atrophy 1 & 2 (GR-PRA1&2)
- Neuronal Ceroid Lipofuscinosis Golden Retriever Type (GR)

Note: This warranty is void if the diagnosis is undetermined or inconclusive. Diseases likely caused by environmental factors (such as poor diet, chemicals, or trauma) are not covered.

If your puppy passes away and you seek a refund, you must have a necropsy performed by a qualified veterinarian at your own expense to determine the cause of death. A refund will be issued if the death is due to a genetic issue or an illness present at the time of purchase. For this reason, we strongly recommend having your puppy examined by your veterinarian within 72 hours of purchase.

For your puppy's long-term health, we advise a diet consisting of at least 20% raw meaty bones, minimal exposure to food additives, and spaying or neutering at 12 months of age or older. We also suggest limiting exposure to veterinary medications (such as flea and heartworm treatments, vaccinations, and dewormers) to the minimum necessary for your pet's health.

Lifetime Rehoming Guarantee

Your puppy comes with a lifetime rehoming guarantee. If, at any point in the future, you find yourself unable to care for your puppy, please contact us. Under no circumstances should your puppy be surrendered to a shelter.
